Second, in each of our homes we will need to prepare bread and drink to eat and drink at the time we take communion. If you are unable to serve grape juice, in these circumstances we encourage you to provide an alternative - even water! (Remember - Jesus gives us living water.) The church through the ages in all places has not always had the fruit of the vine for communion. Alternatives have been used. Honestly, this is what many of our neighboring churches will do, too. Let's remember this. Our union with Christ is what God signs and seals at His table. We focus our faith not on what we eat and drink, but upon our Savior Jesus in heaven to whom we lift our hearts in faith.
